


Why make a Legacy gift?

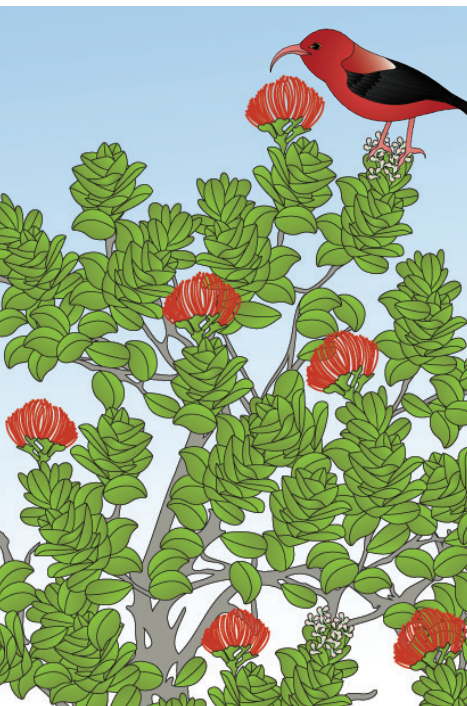
A Legacy gift is one of the most impactful ways you can support The Nature Conservancy's mission. You may be able to save on taxes, receive income for life, or enjoy other financial benefits—all while helping to safeguard Hawai'i's lands and waters for years to come.

Here's how to make a difference for nature now and in the future:

- 1** Include The Nature Conservancy in your will, trust, retirement plan, or life insurance OR contribute a gift that pays you income.
- 2** Tell us about your gift by using the reply form or by contacting Lara Siu, Legacy Club Manager in Hawai'i, at 808-587-6235 or lsiu@tnc.org.
- 3** Initiate a \$2,000 contribution to The Nature Conservancy in Hawai'i for work happening today!

For example...

-  You make a provision for The Nature Conservancy in your will, then notify The Nature Conservancy in Hawai'i. Even if the provision was made in the past, if we did not previously know about it, it will count as a new Legacy commitment! The Legacy Pollinator Fund will make a \$2,000 contribution to The Nature Conservancy in Hawai'i.
-  You name The Nature Conservancy as a primary or contingent beneficiary of a retirement plan, savings account or life insurance policy. Often this is as easy as logging into your account online and updating the beneficiary designation form. After you notify us of the future gift, the Fund will make a \$2,000 contribution to The Nature Conservancy in Hawai'i.
-  You use cash or securities to establish a life-income gift with The Nature Conservancy, such as a Charitable Gift Annuity. The Fund will make a \$2,000 contribution to The Nature Conservancy in Hawai'i.
