

The Nature Conservancy's Muleshoe Ranch Preserve offers comfortably furnished, fully equipped, historic casitas for relaxing weekends. Exclusively for casita guests are the spring fed hot tubs to indulge in after exploring Muleshoe's varied landscape and breathtaking views that include unique and endangered wildlife over miles of scenic trails.

## The Mariposa Casita – *\$170.00 nightly\**

Charming studio with queen bed and cook-top kitchenette and breakfast bar in main room. Microwave, small refrigerator and small single sink only.

Private full bathroom with claw tub/shower and dressing area. Electric heater/AC (shares with Cypress) 2 person maximum

# The Cypress Casita - \$210.00 nightly\*

Roomy with wonderful views, full kitchen, private bedroom with queen bed, large living room with full-sized futon. Private bathroom with modern tub/shower, large dressing area. Electric heat/AC-4 person maximum

# The Forrestine Casita – \$210.00 nightly\*

Full kitchen opens into roomy seating area, private bedroom contains queen bed and daybed. Private bathroom with modern tub/shower. Electric heater/AC - 2 person maximum

## The King Casita - \$225.00 nightly\*

Large, open floor plan with a full electric kitchen, dining area, private bedroom with gueen bed, spacious living room with fullsized futon and 2 twin cots. Private bathroom with modern tub/shower. Private patio close to BBQs. Electric heater/AC - 4 person maximum

## The Stone Cabin – \$220.00 nightly\*

Historic cabin stands alone north of the hot springs area and at the base of the nature trail. Cozy kitchen/dining area, queen bed and full-sized futon. Privacy curtain separates bedroom and living/dining area. Private bathroom with claw tub/shower. Private picnic area, BBQ and patio. Gas Fireplace/No AC - 4 person maximum

All casitas are fully furnished with linens, cookware and tableware.

Trail maps and information about Muleshoe and the area are provided within each casita.

\*Nightly rates are based on double occupancy (2 adults per casita).

Additional guests are \$50 per person-nightly and subject to availability and occupancy limits as deemed appropriate by management.

For parties of two using both bed and futon, there is a one time \$25 fee.

Hot Springs use is limited to adult casita guests.

Pets are not permitted.

### Casita Rentals are available for Members of The Nature Conservancy **Thursday - Monday** from **October through April**

\*Limited availability\* Casita rentals are not offered during the weeks of: Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year.

Wi-Fi is available in the guest lounge. Casitas do not have phones, TV or Wi-Fi. Cellular service is not available at headquarters. Food service/concession is not offered. Guests provide their own meals and beverages.

Muleshoe Headquarters, which includes casitas, business offices and hot spring areas are not open to the public.

Public access to hiking trails, trail maps and information are available from the Day Use Parking Lot located south of the main gate.

### ~RESTRICTIONS~

- Day Use Parking lot is limited to passenger vehicles and exclusively for hikers accessing the trails from dawn until dusk daily. Please park in designated areas only.
- Trailer parking, RV parking, camping and overnight parking are prohibited at Muleshoe Headquarters, in the Day Use Parking Lot, near the kiosk area and on all access roads. Please park in designated areas only.
- Pets are not permitted at any time in casitas, on the preserve, in the parking areas, or on the hiking trails.
- To preserve the natural character of our lands for our wildlife and the privacy of our visitors, we restrict the use of unmanned aerial vehicles - 'drones', whether amateur or commercial, anywhere within this preserve.
- Smoking is not allowed on the preserve, trails, parking areas or casitas.
- Please use headphones if you must listen to music or a sound emitting device. Use of bird calls, or similar sound emitting device is prohibited.
- Collecting of any kind is prohibited.

Other restrictions may apply. Please contact us for current information. Certain portions of our trails are subject to closure

for maintenance and the safety of our guests. Access to other trails will not be affected.
